

Our Christmas Day dinner is fast approaching! I will be asking for cookie trays and desserts from you to share with the community at the Christmas Day dinner.




Our Annual Fall Scrap-A-Thon will be on Friday October 11<sup>th</sup> & Saturday October 12<sup>th</sup>.
